Descriptive Statistical Report for: Hinckley-Finlayson, Minnesota

Response Count:

Middle and High school rows are tallied by the number parents who responded that their child was in either middle school or high school. Those who did not answer what grade their child was in, are only included in the Total row, and will not be seen in either Middle or High school row.

Total Response Rate: 32.8%

The response rate was calculated using the total number of parent households of students in the eligible grades. Two-parent households were sent a single copy of the survey. If students had more than one parent household, each of those households received a copy of the survey.

Margin of Error:

The Margin of Error is calculated based off the population and sample size. As the name implies, the margin of error is a range of values above and below the actual results from a survey. For example, a 60% "yes" response with a margin of error of 5% means that between 55% and 65% of the general population think that the answer is "yes. This Margin of Error only describes the Total row, not the Middle school or High school rows.

NOTE: We chose to use a 95% **confidence level** to find our margin of error. This number expresses how certain we are that the sample accurately reflects the attitudes of the total population. It should also be noted that these survey results were based off a convenience sample, not a simple random sample.
